

Bylaws 7.0 CONVENTIONS AND ELECTIONS

B. . . . If a candidate who was allocated delegates **in a proportion allocation** is not a candidate at the national convention according to the rules of that convention, then all the delegates shall be re-allocated and bound to the remaining candidates in accordance to the rules in this section.

If a candidate who won the majority of votes in the presidential primary or presidential caucus (and thus received all of the national delegates) is not a candidate at the national convention according to the rules of that convention, then the national delegates shall be unbound and can either vote for the withdrawn majority vote getting candidate or a remaining candidate in accordance to the rules of this section.
