This is the official communication from the Utah Republican Party to all State Central Committee members regarding the upcoming State Central Committee meeting.

The next State Central Committee meeting will be held at the **Salt Lake Board of Realtors, 230 West Town Ridge Parkway Ste. 200, Sandy, Utah 84070**. The meeting will convene **at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 4, 2016**. Registration will begin at 8 a.m. To submit an excused absence for this meeting, please send an email to bryce@utgop.org.

There are several items to be aware of as you prepare for the meeting:

1. County Chairs and Vice-Chairs should plan to attend a 30-minute meeting at **9:00 a.m.** before the SCC body meets.
2. The committee will elect a replacement secretary as outlined in URP Constitution Article 3 Section D "1. Vacancies. Officer vacancies shall be filled within ninety (90) days of the vacancy by the State Central Committee."
3. The committee will discuss various items related to the 2016 election cycle, including Presidential Caucus online voting, caucus night, the nominating convention, and the general election, and an SB 54 update.
4. Any Resolution submitted by Friday, May 13th at 5 p.m. will be posted at www.utah.gop under the State Central Committee tab.
5. Any Constitution & Bylaw amendment submitted by Friday, May 13th at 5 p.m. will be posted at www.utah.gop under the State Central Committee tab.
6. The committee will hear Officer, Committee, and Delegation reports.
7. Minutes from the February 6, 2016 SCC meeting will be available online and at the upcoming meeting.
8. The next four State Central Committee meeting dates are tentatively:
 - A. October 1, 2016
 - B. December 3, 2016
 - C. February 4, 2017
 - D. June 3, 2017
